

Guidelines for Students Seeking Two Options

- 1. The student must present a rationale for the double option and a plan of study leading to completion of the degree in <u>four years</u>.
- 2. The plan must be approved by a committee composed of the option representatives of <u>both</u> options.
- 3. The plan must meet the minimum requirements for both options as set forth in the catalog, but the committee may impose additional requirements as well.
- 4. Each option will be responsible for assigning an advisor.
- 5. The approved request must be submitted to the Registrar <u>before</u> the start of the senior year. Changes to the program will require approval by <u>both</u> advisors.
